How to Answer Question 6: What does the Author Repeat?

Qs 6-9 shift our attention to items the author emphasizes, beginning with repetition.

- 1. Read through the study passage again, looking for words, phrases, or topics the author mentions multiple times.
- On your Scripture-study sheets, mark every mention of the first repeated concept and its opposite, including synonyms, adjectives, pronouns, and antonyms;
 OR
 - if you aren't using a Scripture-study sheet, note everything the author says about the first repeated concept and its opposite in your study journal.
- 3. Continue marking or making notes about each repeated item in the passage.

Hints & Hacks

- If you decide to mark the text, **keep a master list of your markings** in your study materials. This way you can consistently mark all instances of a concept anytime you find it in study text. This list will also prevent you from reusing the same symbol for different concepts.
- I mark antonyms using my symbol for the concept with a red circle and slash over it.
- If you're working with a **poetry** passage, be aware the author may use **personal pronouns** (*she*, *her*) to refer to a concept like *wisdom*. Mark these as you answer Question 6, and keep them in mind as you answer Question 7 about comparisons.
